Dear Mr. Melendrez,

This letter is to notify you of an incident involving one of your trucks and the steps being taken by KBDJ, LP to prevent potential accidents in the future. Your company subcontracts with our customer, Lone Star Infrastructure, to haul road materials from our Hays County limestone quarry to the S.H. 130 toll road project. Therefore, your cooperation in this serious matter is both expected and appreciated.

On November 29, at approximately 1:30 p.m., a neighbor of ours was driving westbound on F.M. 967 and preparing to turn into the Ruby Ranch subdivision when she noticed in her rear-view mirror an 18-wheeler approaching her at a fast rate of speed. Fearing the truck was going to hit her, she stepped on the accelerator and quickly turned left into the neighborhood. Had there been oncoming traffic in the eastbound lane, she likely would have been hit head-on.

While visibly shaken by the incident, our neighbor wrote down the license plate of the truck, called the Hays County Sheriff's Office, and gave a statement to the KBDJ scale house operator. We instructed the driver to wait until the officer arrived, which he did.

The subsequent investigation has determined that the truck (#1906) belongs to your company and was driven by Richard Juarez. **Effective immediately, Richard Juarez is prohibited from hauling materials from the KBDJ site.** Furthermore, we urge you to share the incident with all drivers of Melendrez Brothers Trucking and remind them that the safety of our community must be a top priority.
